




BASTIAANSKLOOF MANAGEMENT CC



Via Du Toitskloof Tunnel on the N1

Travel out from Cape Town on the N1. Travel until you reach the Du Toitskloof Toll, for which you will have to pay R30.00 to pass through. Go through the Du Toitskloof Tunnel and drive for approximately 20 minutes towards Worcester. Just before Worcester, on the left hand side, you will see a sign for the R43 to Ceres and on the corner is a Shell Ultra City Petrol Garage. Turn left onto the R43 and travel all the way along (about 20 minutes/28km). After 28km you will see a sign on the left hand side saying left to Bainskloof/Wellington R301 – turn left here. If you carry on straight you will end up at Woseley/Ceres. Travel over 2 small bridges, past the Calabash Bush Pub on your right and approximately 1km on your right from there are three cottages (you will see the Bastiaanskloof sign on the black gate). When you reach the 3 cottages, carry on driving for another 0.5km and on your right is a second gate with the sign “Bastiaanskloof Private”. The gate will be open, follow the dirt track for approximately half a kilometre- you will see the Kraal Cottage on the right hand side.

From Cape Town via Wellington and Bainskloof pass (there is a height restriction for vehicles of 3.8 metres)

Travel out from Cape Town on the N1. Take exit 47, signposted as the Wellington/Klapmuts off ramp (an approximately 45 minute drive). Turn left at the stop sign, just after taking the off ramp and drive in the direction of Wellington, along the R44. Drive along the R44 all the way until you reach a T-junction (there will be a cemetery on your right), an approximately 20/25 minute drive. At these traffic lights, turn left into Piet Retief Street (R303). At the next set of traffic lights, (the Dutch Reformed Church will be on your left) turn right into the R301 (Church Street/Kerk Straat) to Bainskloof. Keep on this road all the way over the Bainskloof pass. You will pass Eerste Tol at the top of the pass and then the road will begin descending. The next

landmark will be the Limietberg Nature Conservation camp site (on your left). Driving a bit further you will pass Steenboks Park, also on the left hand side.

After Steenboks Park, it is about 3/4km to the main gate leading to India House and the Kraal Cottage on the left hand side of the road. There is a sign saying "Bastiaanskloof Private". The main gate will be open. Follow the dirt track for approximately half a kilometre - you will see the Kraal Cottage on your right. If you reach our 3 cottages on the left, 0.5 km further down the R301 you have gone too far!
